

NorthShore Classical Academy secures loan for campus improvements

School to now open in fall 2027

SAUKVILLE — Now eyeing a fall 2027 opening, NorthShore Classical Academy has secured necessary financing needed to begin renovating its Saukville campus at 341 S. Dries St.

The private, nonprofit high school that will serve grades nine through 12 was founded by former Mequon-Thiensville School Board member Cheryl Rebholz. It received approval from the village of Saukville's Plan Commission to open a new campus in a former Christian grade school building that dates back more than 150 years ago.

The historic building, which was initially home to a Catholic parish school and then to Ozaukee Christian School contains 11 classrooms, administrative offices, a full-size gymnasium with three basketball courts, expansive sports fields, as well as a large cafeteria and commercial kitchen.

According to NCA, Bank First, through its Cedarburg office, has now provided a loan that will enable it to break ground on the first phase of a multi-phase renovation plan. NCA Boards

of Directors in April revealed that the school's fall 2026 opening was delayed due to "a variety of factors," including unexpected construction delays and a "longer-than-anticipated" process to secure financing.

"NCA was founded to provide families with an exceptional classical education rooted in truth, goodness and virtue," Rebholz said. "This financing will allow us to create a permanent home that will support that mission, reflect the excellence of the education taking place within it and serve generations of students to come. We are grateful to Joe Nelson, Bank First's region president, and his team for their belief in and support of NCA. Thank you, also, to everyone who has supported this project with encouragement, prayers, volunteer efforts and financial gifts. Their partnership has made this milestone possible."

NCA will now embark on a multi-phase renovation plan, with initial work on the new building including:

- updating all electrical equipment and systems;

- replacing the roof;
- painting the interior;
- renovating two classrooms with improved acoustics and lighting, and also classroom furniture; and
- renovating the bathrooms with additional fixtures and stalls, and to meet Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

The construction timeline is currently being developed.

The school is also in search of its next head of school, as Rebholz noted that Tim Dosemagen resigned as NCA's head of school earlier this year for personal reasons. Dosemagen was to report to the school's Board of Directors and be responsible for recruiting and mentoring faculty and staff, guiding academic planning and instruction, managing school operations and budgeting, shaping NCA's culture, among other duties.
